
- 2 Nights hotel accommodation

- Stately Oaks Plantation A beautifully restored antebellum plantation, reminiscent of Tara, from Gone with the Wind. It was built in 1838 in the Greek Revival style and is named for the large trees surrounding it. Stately Oaks has the distinction of housing both Northern and Southern troops during the Civil War in 1864.
- Leisure time for some shopping Underground Atlanta is located in the heart of the city and is one of the most popular visitor attractions in Georgia.
   It is a shopping center, running the length of six city blocks and a spirited marketplace, boasting over 100 specialty stores as well as 12 restaurants.

- All hotel & meal taxes and gratuities




